

General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) Guided Pathway

The General Education Core Curriculum consists of 37-41 credits of the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) general education courses taken from five different categories including communications, social and behavioral sciences, physical and life sciences, mathematics, and humanities and fine arts. Successful completion of this credential ensures a seamless transfer of lower-level general education requirements to four-year universities in the State of Illinois. Students must maintain a minimum of 2.0 (C average). This credential can be included on official transcripts.

GECC courses are offered fall, spring, and summer. The GECC can be completed in one year including summer or in two years for students electing two courses per semester including summer.

GECC Pathway

Guided pathways are recommended course sequences for earning a certificate or degree. Waubonsee's academic and career advising and counseling professionals are available to guide students on their path to graduate.
