The Auto Body Repair Program provides students hands-on skills in body repair, surface preparation, painting, and frame repair. Student who successfully complete this program are prepared to take the Automotive Service excellence (ASE) Auto body Certification exam and to begin their career as an auto body repair technician.

Auto Body Repair is a full-time cohort program. Students are required to register for all courses in a given semester.
