

Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) Transfer Degree Guided Pathway

Guided pathways are recommended course sequences for earning a certificate or degree. The Associate in Fine Arts is a <u>specialty transfer degree</u> designed for students interested in transferring to a four-year institution to pursue a bachelor's of fine art degree. Students should consult with Academic and Career Advising prior to following this pathway.

The AFA degree does not fulfill the requirements of the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum (GECC). Students must complete the general education requirement of the institution to which they transfer.
