## Pre-Med:

AU: Students should take MTH 131 instead of MTH 211. BIO 250, BIO 270, BIO 272, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 202, CHM 231, CHM 232, PHY 221, PHY 222, and PSY 205

BU: Recommend MTH 107, PSY 100 and SOC 100

ISU: CHM 121, CHM122, CHM 202, CHM 231, CHM 232, MTH 131, PHY 221, PHY 222. MTH 107 recommended.

NIU: Additional classes in sociology and psychology are recommended, including PSY 100 and classes in social, cognitive, and abnormal psychology.

UIC: BIO 120, BIO 122, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 231, PHY 111/PHY 221, PHY 112/222. Recommended: MTH 107, MTH 130, PSY 100, SOC 100

UIUC: BIO 120, BIO 122, BIO 270, BIO 272, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 231, CHM 232, PHY 111, PHY 112. Recommended: PSY 100, SOC 100

## **Pre-Dentistry:**

AU: BIO 270, BIO 272, BIO 250, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 202, CHM 231, CHM 232, PHY 221, and PHY 222

BU: Recommend MTH 107, BIO 250, 270, and 272

NIU: Most dental schools require PSY 100, PSYC 205, MTH 107

## Pre-Vet:

BU: Recommend courses in Genetics and Biochemistry, Need 30 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences and Humanities/Fine Arts

ISU: BIO 120, BIO 122, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 202, CHM 231, CHM 232, PHY 111/221, PHY 112/222, MTH 131

NIU: Many veterinary programs require one semester of animal science. Applied animal science classes are not offered at NIU, but can typically be taken at a community college

over the summer. (Not at WCC)

UIC: BIO 120, BIO 122, CHM 121, CHM 122, CHM 231, PHY 111/PHY 221, PHY 112/222. Recommended: CHM 232
