## Associate in Applied Science Degree in Nursing Program Admissions Checklist 2024

- □ NEW STUDENTS: complete the online <u>New Student Application</u>.
- Meet with the <u>Academic and Career Advising Center</u> to establish a schedule for taking prerequisites at Waubonsee. Submit OFFICAL transcripts for prerequisites not taken at Waubonsee to <u>Registration</u> <u>and Records</u>.
- □ IF NEEDED: Contact <u>Learning Assessment and Testing Services</u> to make an appointment for full-time assessment (English placement may be required to enroll in ENG101 or 102).
- □ To request evaluation for advanced placement in Nursing courses: submit OFFICAL transcripts for Nursing courses not taken at Waubonsee to <u>Registration and Records</u>. ISend syllabi in effect at time of course enrollment to <u>Nursing@waubonsee.edu</u>.
- □ Review current guidelines for the <u>ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills)</u>. Determine the best study and testing plan for final testing results PRIOR your preferred enrollment deadline.
- □ Include valid LPN license with application to be evaluated for prior learning credit.
- Understand that once accepted into the program, students <u>must</u>:
  - $\circ$  Attend the mandatory new student orientation to the nursing program
  - $_{\odot}$  Follow the NUR course sequence and maintain a 2.0 (C) or better GPA in each course.
  - Register and maintain personal Immunization account used to gather and store clinical data for the nursing program. Details given upon acceptance and confirmation into the program.
  - Submit documentation <u>required</u> for clinicals:
    - Current American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider CPR (online AND in-person components)
    - o Current health insurance
    - o Medical Clearance and Release, TB test, and immunizations including:
      - COVID-19 now strongly suggested.
      - Annual influenza by 10/1 for fall admission, before start date Spring admission.
      - TDaP (documentation of boosters)
      - MMR, Hepatitis B and Varicella (titers)
