- ✓ Date of access is optional, please check with your instructor.
- ✓ Medium of publication is omitted.
- ✓ Omit http:// or https:// when writing a URL.
- ✓ All entries should be double-spaced.

Encyclopedia article, no author, from a multi-volume set, edition	<p>"Nike." <i>Encyclopedia of Global Brands</i>. 2nd ed., vol. 2, St. James Press, 2013, pp. 750-54.</p>
Song	<p>Beyoncé. "Pray You Catch Me." <i>Lemonade</i>, Parkwood Entertainment, 2016. www.beyonce.com/album/lemonade-visual-album/.</p>
Twitter	<p>@ReallyVirtual (Sohaib Athar). When quoting the Tweet, beside any grammatical and spelling errors in the original Tweet, write [sic] in square brackets to indicate the errors are not your own. E.g., if the Tweet was "It isn't you're fault the media is violent", write: "It isn't you're [sic] fault the media is violent."</p>
