Book, one author	Bartholomew, M. (2017). <i>Adcreep: The case against modern marketing</i> . Stanford University Press.
YouTube Video	Science News. (2019, October 9). <i>See a simulation of the cosmic web</i> [Video]. YouTube. https://youtu.be/wzCFxkOjlj8

Notes

- Reference list entries should be double-spaced.
- For a **website**, when the author is the same as the publisher, usually for an organization, omit the publisher in your reference. See World Health Organization example above.
- For an **ebook**, the reference is the same as for the print, unless there is a doi. If there is a doi, it should be included.
- For **YouTube**, the uploader or account name is the author. If the creator of the content is different, include this in the title. Example:

TED. (2019, June 3). *Matt Walker: Sleep is your superpower* [Video]. YouTube. <https://youtu.be/5MulMqhT8DM>

Encyclopedia article online - no DOI	Newton, M. (2008). Crime scene investigation. In <i>The encyclopedia of crime scene investigation</i> . (pp. 65-66). Facts on File. Note: Include pp. before page numbers for encyclopedia articles and book chapters, but not for periodical articles.
Song	Childish Gambino. (2018). This is America [Song]. mcDJ; RCA. Note: Include a URL if that is the only location where the song is available, such as the artist website.
